On December 11th, 2009 the Department of Homeland Security announced \$293,000,000 in grant funding for transit security for 2010. The deadline for submitting requests for transit security programs is February 18, 2010. While this deadline is looming many agencies are struggling with allocating leftover or unused funds to projects from past years. Several agencies have opted to utilize these funds for an initial implementation of MAGTEC's Positive Bus Control technology.
